THERE may be no such thing as a free lunch, but there is a meal which donates £1 per diner to charity.

Charitablebookings.org is a new restaurant reservation service that gives back to charity at no cost to diners.

There are currently more than 4,000 restaurants signed up and each time you book, the site donates £1 to charity for each person in the party, to a charity of the booker's choice.

Customers can choose one charity for each reservation from a list of more than 7,500 – from local projects to global causes including the environment,

veterans, the homeless, animal welfare, and children's wellbeing.

Founder David Johnstone said: "We created the Charitable bookings service as a platform to benefit not only charities but restaurants and users alike. A nice win-win all-round."
